Among her most notable novels are "Pride and Prejudice," "Sense and Sensibility," "Emma," and "Persuasion." Although she published anonymously during her lifetime, after her death she became one of the most influential writers in world literature.

Anne Elliot, the daughter of a debt-ridden baronet, had rejected Frederick Wentworth, a marine, years earlier due to family pressure. Eight years later, they reunite when Anne's family rents their house, and Wentworth returns as a wealthy captain. Eventually, he writes a letter to Anne confessing his feelings, and the two become engaged and eventually marry.
